Set in Miami in 1981, as the twentieth anniversary of the Bay of Pigs fiasco approaches, Los Gusanos is the explosive account of a group of Cuban exiles who plan to mark the anniversary by blowing up a power plant at the site of the failed invasion. The exiles include the righteous Marta de la Pena Cruz, who is driven by the desire to avenge her brother's death at the Bay of Pigs; Marta's uncle Felix, a former gunrunner for Castro; Padre Martin, a defrocked priest; and El Halcon, a shady character who was once in Batista's secret police. Well-armed but poorly prepared, fueled by the passion of extreme exile politics, they set off for Cuba, haunted by the memories of pre-Castro Cuba.

Filled with passion, violence, sex, and history—and taking its title from the derogatory term Castro used to describe those who fled after he came to power—Los Gusanos is a rare combination of literary fiction and visceral storytelling, in the vein of Elmore Leonard and Graham Greene. Through flashback and a memorable ensemble of characters, Sayles creates a vivid canvas of the last fifty years of Cuban life as seen through one extended family's life in Cuba and the United States.
